New Mexico Medicaid and SNAP Fast Facts

- Over 50% of all New Mexicans are currently enrolled in Medicaid
- Over 83% of all births in New Mexico are covered under Medicaid
- Over 500,000 New Mexico residents (1 in 4) receive SNAP benefits
- New Mexico has the largest share of residents enrolled in SNAP in the nation

Medicaid and SNAP Eligibility Requirements Have Changed

- During the COVID-19 public health emergency, the state was required to provide continuous coverage without active renewal or eligibility determination
- New Federal laws have eliminated continuous enrollment requirements
- All Medicaid and SNAP customers will be notified by the New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) when it is time for them to renew their Medicaid & SNAP eligibility
- Medicaid and SNAP customers must renew, or they will lose their benefits

How New Mexicans Might Lose Their Medicaid and/or SNAP Coverage

- They may not be aware that they need to renew their eligibility
- Their contact information may be outdated
- They may no longer qualify for Medicaid or SNAP
- They may be unaware of low-cost health insurance options through beWellnm.com

How You Can Help Keep New Mexico Covered

- Remind patients that they must renew their Medicaid and SNAP eligibility when they
 receive their turquoise envelope from HSD, or they will lose their benefits
- Remind your patients how important it is to update their contact information by clicking the chat icon at yes.state.nm.us
